Short Title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 650 AND HOUSE BILL 669 RELATING TO RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS AND SHOPPING CENTERS; REQUIRING CERTAIN PARKING LOTS TO CONTAIN A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF PARKING SPACES DESIGNATED FOR EXPECTANT MOTHERS, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR SIGNAGE AND MARKINGS FOR SUCH PARKING SPACES; REQUIRING CERTAIN RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS AND SHOPPING CENTERS TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN BREASTFEEDING AREAS; DEFINING THE TERM "BREASTFEEDING AREA"; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

Commissioner Michele Lazarow requested staff bring forward a Resolution supporting Senate Bill 650, sponsored by Senator Lauren F. Brook, and House Bill 669, sponsored by Representative Jared E. Moskowitz.

SB 650 and HB 669 are similar companion state legislative bills relating to retail establishments and shopping centers parking spaces for expectant mothers. If adopted by the Florida Legislature, both bills would create section 316.1966 of the Florida Statue requiring certain parking lots to contain a minimum amount of parking spaces designated for use by expectant mothers. In addition, both bills would require the Florida Department of Transportation to establish requirement for signage and markings for such parking places. Lastly, HB 669 would amend section 383.015 of the Florida Statute by requiring certain retail establishments and shopping centers to provide and maintain breastfeeding areas.

By approving the attached Resolution, the City Commission would be supporting the creation of section 316.1966 of the Florida Statue providing designated parking spaces for expectant mothers, and an amendment to section 383.015 of the Florida Statute providing for breastfeeding areas in certain retail establishments and shopping centers.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, a Resolution adopted by the Commission is an expression of the Commission on matters of official concern and opinion.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact to the City related to this item.

Proposed Action:

The City Commission consider the attached Resolution supporting SB 650 and HB 669 relating to retail establishments and shopping centers parking spaces for expectant mothers.
