5 6 7	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 320 AND
8	HOUSE BILL 627 RELATING TO DOGS IN VEHICLES;
9 10	REQUIRING PERSONS TRANSPORTING A DOG IN AN OPEN AREA OF ANY VEHICLE OR TRAILER TO KEEP
11	THE DOG WITHIN CERTAIN SECURED CONTAINERS OR
12 13	SECURELY TETHER THE DOG; PROVIDING THAT VIOLATIONS ARE PUNISHABLE AS NONCRIMINAL
13 14	TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN
15	EFFECTIVE DATE.
16	
17	WHEREAS, proper safety and well-being requirements should be mandated in the
18	transportation of dogs, and dogs being transported in open vehicles may be particularly
19 20	susceptible to injury; and
20	WHEREAS, proposed legislation would require a person transporting a dog on a
21	public street or highway in the open bed of a pickup truck or an open area of any vehicle
22	or trailer to keep the dog within a secure kennel, cage, or other ventilated container or
23	securely tether the dog to the vehicle or trailer in such a way as to prevent the dog from
24	falling from the vehicle or trailer and to prevent injury to the animal; and
25	WHEREAS, the proposed legislation would enable police to enforce the violation
26	thereof as a nonmoving traffic violation; and
27	WHEREAS, the proposed legislation in Senate Bill 320 and House Bill 627 would
28	create statewide requirements for the safekeeping of dogs in open area vehicles
29	
30	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
31	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
32	
33	SECTION 1. Support of Senate Bill 320 and House Bill 627. The Mayor and
34	City Commission hereby support Senate Bill 320 and House Bill 627, relating to requiring
35	persons transporting a dog in an open area of any vehicle or trailer to keep the dog within
36	certain secured containers or securely tether the dog.
37	

38	SECTION 2. Directions to City Manager and City Clerk. The Mayor and City
39	Commission direct the City Manager to take all necessary steps to effectuate this
40	resolution and direct the Clerk to cause a copy of this resolution to be forwarded to all
41	appropriate parties.

43	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
44	its passage and adoption.
