3 4 5 6 7	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, STRONGLY OPPOSING HOUSE BILL 0017 PREEMPTING NEW LOCAL REGULATION OF BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9	WHEREAS, local government is the level of government closest to the people and citizens
10	have relied on their local governments to govern our many communities in a manner that reflects
11 12	local preferences and necessarily involves the regulation of businesses.; and
13	WHEREAS, a well-run municipality ensures a higher quality of life for its residents by
14 15	protecting their safety and environment while maximizing economic opportunity; and
16	WHEREAS, often the consequences of a business practice, profession or occupation may
17	only be apparent at the local level and affect the daily lives of residents; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, businesses should not be forced to navigate the state legislative process for
20	minor matters that are easily addressed at the local level. This is particularly problematic for small
21	businesses, which may lack the resources to pursue matters legislatively. Local governments are
22	the most accessible venue to resolve business concerns because they are closest to the people
23	and most familiar with their communities; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, if enacted, House Bill 0017 would preempt the ability of local governments to
26	issue reasonable and necessary regulations on businesses, professions, and occupations
27	affecting the community unless the state legislature expressly authorizes local regulation
28	Amending existing regulations and responding to new local issues would require a statewide
29	response that is likely to delay action, impede businesses and frustrate residents; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, a blanket preemption of all new regulations robs the public of the ability to
32	determine which level of government is best suited to regulate a particular area of the law. State
33	level government may not understand or be responsive to local issues and concerns; and
34	

35	WHEREAS, the language of the proposed HB 0017 is extremely broad and likely to resul
36	in unfortunate, unforeseeable, and unintended consequences harming the City's residents.
37	
38	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
39	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
40	
41	SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Commission strongly oppose the legislation proposed
42	in House Bill 0017 preempting to the state the ability to issue any new regulation on a business
43	profession, and occupation unless expressly authorized by general law.
44	SECTION 2. Directions to City Manager and City Clerk. The Mayor and City
45	Commission direct the City Manager to take all necessary steps to effectuate this resolution and
46	direct the Clerk to cause a copy of this resolution to be forwarded to all appropriate parties.
47	
48	SECTION 3. Effective date. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately
49	upon its passage and adoption.
