3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY BUS SYSTEM BY EXPANDING SERVICE TO ROUTE 1 (RED ROUTE); AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL BUS TO SERVICE ROUTE 1 TO REDUCE HEADWAYS; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE REDIRECTION OF ROUTES 1 (RED ROUTE) & 2 (BLUE ROUTE) ON SITE AT THE WALMART DEVELOPMENT AND REDIRECTING ROUTE 3 (GREEN ROUTE) & ROUTE 4 (ORANGE ROUTE) AT THE AUSTIN HEPBURN CENTER/OB JOHNSON PARK; AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$175,000.00) DOLLARS FOR THE COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (ILA) AND RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
23 24	WHEREAS, the City's Community Bus System is a free service provided to
25	residents and visitors of Hallandale Beach. It consists of four (4) routes; and
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27	WHEREAS, the City's community bus is serviced by Limousines of South Florida
28	("LOSF") and has been in operation for over fifteen (15) years. LOSF provides the bus,
29	the driver, maintenance of the bus and fuel; and
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31	WHEREAS, the Community Bus Service is funded in part by a grant from
32	Broward County Transit. The term of the current Interlocal Agreement (ILA) ends on
33	September 30, 2017, with an option to be extended up to two (2) additional one (1) year
34	renewal periods upon written approval of the Contract Administrator ninety (90) days
35	prior to the expiration of the current term; and
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37	WHEREAS, grant funding for FY 2016-2017 is two hundred twenty two thousand
38	four hundred eighty (\$222,480.00) dollars. The funding is based on the estimated
39	numbers of operating days; and
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WHEREAS, the County contributes fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per hour for twelve
(12) hour days; six (6) days a week for the four (4) routes. As per the grant agreement,
the City shall not deviate from the established route without the written consent of the
Contract Administrator; and

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WHEREAS, at a joint budget workshop/special meeting on Wednesday, August
24, 2016, the City Commission by motion increased funding for the City's circular system
by one hundred seventy five thousand (\$175,000.00) dollars with the priority of adding
an additional bus or an additional route to decrease the headways; and

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51 WHEREAS, in accordance with the ILA, the City in compliance with the 52 provisions of 49 U.S.C. Section 5307(c) 1) (I), the City shall hold a public hearing before 53 its governing body prior to any changes in service affecting twenty five percent (25%) or 54 more to the route miles, when calculated on total route miles or on daily revenue miles, 55 as well as prior to implementing headway adjustments of more than fifteen (15) minutes; 56 and

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58 WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends City Commission authorization 59 to accept the changes to the Hallandale Beach community bus system by expanding 60 service to route 1 (red route); authorizing an additional bus to service route 1 to reduce 61 headways; further authorizing the redirection of routes 1 (red route) & 2 (blue route) on 62 site at the Walmart development and redirecting route 3 (green route) & route 4 (orange 63 route) at the Austin Hepburn Center/OB Johnson park; authorizing additional funding in 64 the amount not to exceed one hundred seventy five thousand (\$175,000.00) dollars for 65 the community bus service; and authorizing the city manager to execute any 66 amendments to the ILA agreement and related documents to effectuate implementation 67 of the project.

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## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

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SECTION 1. City Commission Authorization. The Mayor and City
 Commission authorize the City Manager to implement changes to the Hallandale Beach
 community bus system by expanding service to route 1 (red route); authorizing an

75	additional bus to service route 1 to reduce headways; and further authorize the
76	redirection of routes 1 (red route) & 2 (blue route) on site at the Walmart development
77	and redirecting route 3 (green route) & route 4 (orange route) at the Austin Hepburn
78	Center/OB Johnson park.
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80	SECTION 2. City Commission Authorization to Expend Funding. The Mayor
81	and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to expend additional funding as
82	budgeted in the FY 2016-2017 budget in the amount not to exceed one hundred seventy
83	five thousand (\$175,000.00) dollars for the expansion of the community mini bus service.
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85	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
86	authorize the City Manager to execute any amendments to the Interlocal Agreement
87	(ILA) agreement and related documents to effectuate implementation of the project.
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89	SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage
90	and adoption.
