

RESOLUTION NO. 2016 - 162

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SIXTY TWO (62) REPLACEMENT UNITS AND TWO (2) NEW UNITS INCLUDING TRUCKS, VEHICLES, AND EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,497,500.00) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE AS PROVIDED FOR IN FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 Exception to Bid Requirements (6) Bids and Contracts from Other entities, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchasing, the City Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services from other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be served subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission approved the establishment of a Fleet Fund during the 2012 City Commission and City Manager Budget Workshops in order to simplify and optimize the efficiency of new City vehicle purchases and allow for their on-going maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of the Fleet Fund also implemented a Leasing Program whereby each year the various city departments that utilize Fleet vehicles would budget an amount appropriate for the on-going maintenance and programmed replacement of their vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of this initiative, a detailed Fleet Maintenance and Replacement Program (FMRP) was developed, capturing optimal service life for each vehicle, combines with the point in time where the City could glean the highest resale value for each vehicle; and

39           **WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2016, Contract #FSA16-VEL24.0 and Contract  
40 #FSA16-VEH14.0 were awarded to a number of vehicle vendors, and the City wishes to  
41 utilize the two (2) contracts in order to procure vehicles during the 2016-2017 fiscal year;

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44           **WHEREAS**, at the September 22, 2016, Budget Meeting, the Mayor and the City  
45 Commission approved the City Administration's recommendations to acquire sixty two  
46 (62) replacement vehicles and two (2) new units, which include equipment, trucks, and  
47 vehicles for the 2016-2017 fiscal year for a total amount not to exceed two million four  
48 hundred ninety seven thousand five hundred (\$2,497,500.00) dollars; and  
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50           **WHEREAS**, the City Administration believes it is cost effective and in the best  
51 interest of the City to utilize the Florida Sheriff's Association Contracts #FSA16-VEL24.0  
52 and #FSA16-VEH14.0 to purchase sixty two (62) replacements units and two (2) new  
53 units, and authorizing outfitting a portion of purchased vehicles with emergency equipment  
54 with the Broward County Sheriff's Office Bid #13104030 during fiscal year 2016-2017; and  
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56           **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best  
57 interest of the City and its residents to authorize the City Manager to purchase sixty two  
58 (62) replacement units and two (2) new units utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association  
59 Contracts #FSA16-VEL24.0 and #FSA16-VEH14.0, and utilizing the Broward County  
60 Sheriff's Office Bid #13104030, and National Joint Powers Alliance Contract #102811-  
61 NAF with National AutoFleet Group to outfit a portion of purchased vehicles with  
62 emergency equipment for a total amount not to exceed two million four hundred ninety  
63 seven thousand five hundred (\$2,497,500.00) dollars.

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65           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
66 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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68           **SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization.**           The Mayor and City  
69 Commission hereby authorize the utilization of the Florida Sheriff's Association Contracts  
70 #FSA16-VEL24.0 and #FSA16-VEH14.0 to purchase sixty two (62) replacement units and  
71 two (2) new units, authorizing the utilization of Broward County Sheriff's Office Bid  
72 #13104030, and authorizing National Joint Powers Alliance Contract #102811-NAF with

73 National AutoFleet Group to outfit a portion of purchased vehicles with emergency  
74 equipment with the for a total amount not to exceed two million four hundred ninety seven  
75 thousand five hundred (\$2,497,500.00) dollars, as provided in fiscal year 2016-2017  
76 budget. Authorizing the City Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate the  
77 purchase.

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79 **SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect  
80 immediately upon its passage and adoption.
