6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO OPPOSE SENATE BILL 596 AND HOUSE BILL 687 WHICH ELIMINATES LOCAL CONTROL FOR FLORIDA CITIES WITH RESPECT TO TAXPAYER OWNED PUBLIC STRUCTURES AND RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PLACEMENT OF "SMALL" OR "MICRO" WIRELESS ANTENNAS AND EQUIPMENT AND PROHIBITS LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FROM REGULATING ANYTHING EXCEPT APPLICABLE BUILDING CODES FOR WIRELESS INFRASTRUCTURE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
18 19	WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature is considering SB 596/HB 687, which would
20	blatantly interfere with the ability of hundreds of communities to protect public safety and
21	maintain their local, unique look and feel; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the proposed legislation would allow an unchecked proliferation of
24	new poles and equipment that could jeopardize public safety by interfering with
25	pedestrians, enticing kids to climb recklessly, creating additional debris in a hurricane, and
26	tying up space that should be reserved for police/fire radio antennas; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, the proposed legislation would preempt local control including the
29	ability to bury utility lines. Those communities would be forced to allow ugly, invasive
30	towers up to 60 feet high on public-access land and accept refrigerator-sized equipment
31	glommed onto existing structures or sidewalks in public rights-or-way, creating a
32	permanent eyesore; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, SB 596/HB 687 if passed, will stomp out local decision-making by
35	stripping the decision-making from the hands of the local community's elected officials and
36	allow Big Telecom companies to be given preferential treatment to "cut in line" in the local
37	permit review process, making everyone else second-class citizens; and

39	WHEREAS, local governments should not be prevented from protecting their
40	citizens as they see fit from the risks posed to the public welfare by Telecom companies;
41	and
42	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the residents
43	and public should strongly urge the Florida Legislature to oppose Senate Bill 596/House
44	Bill 687 which would eliminate local control for Florida cities with respect to taxpayer
45	owned public structures and right-of-way for placement of "small" or "micro" wireless
46	antennas and equipment and prohibits local governments from regulating anything except
47	applicable building codes for wireless infrastructure.

49	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
50	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
51 52	SECTION 1. Opposing Senate Bill 596 and House Bill 687. The Mayor and City
53	Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach strongly urge the Florida Legislature to
54	oppose Senate Bill 596/House Bill 687 which would eliminate local control for Florida cities
55	with respect to taxpayer owned public structures and right-of-way for placement of "small"
56	or "micro" wireless antennas and equipment and also prohibit local governments from
57	regulating anything except applicable building codes for wireless infrastructure.
58	
59	SECTION 2. Directions to City Manager. The Mayor and City Commission
60	direct the City Manager to cause a copy of this resolution to be forwarded to all appropriate
61	parties.

63	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
64	its passage and adoption.
