17	MULTIPLAS the improper and illegal placement of oning signs and pactors on utility
18 19	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the improper and illegal placement of snipe signs and posters on utility poles, utility boxes, traffic control boxes, bus shelters, benches, trees, or any other public
20	property is of great concern to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City
21	of Hallandale Beach; and
22	WHEREAS, illegally placed snipe signs and posters placed on utility poles, utility
23 24	boxes, traffic control boxes, bus shelters, benches, trees, or any other public property can be found throughout this City and such signs are often replaced after removal by the City;
25	and
26	WHEREAS, the City is limited in its enforcement capabilities against violators or
27	businesses caught or located within the City's boundaries; and
28	WHEREAS, the improper and illegal placement of snipe signs and posters is a
29	countywide issue as these signs advertise events that take place not only within the City,
30	but throughout the County; and
31	WHEREAS, the Broward County Graffiti and Illegal Poster Task Force ("Task
32	Force") has been meeting since September 21, 2016; and
33	WHEREAS, the Task Force has identified Art Wrapping Utility and Traffic Control
34	Boxes to be an effective means of deterrence against the unlawfully placed posters; and
35	WHEREAS, Art Wrapping Utility and Traffic Control Boxes is not a cure-all solution
36	and greater enforcement efforts are required to counteract this growing problem; and
37	WHEREAS, a countywide ordinance which holds violators, venues, and
38	businesses responsible for placement of illegal snipe signs and posters is necessary to
39	ensure that violators are unable to evade municipal code enforcement through

jurisdictional limitations; and

41	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe that a countywide ordinance
42	which holds venues, businesses, and other responsible parties accountable for snipe
43	signs and posters unlawfully placed on utility poles, utility boxes, traffic control boxes, bus
44	shelters, benches, trees or any other public property is necessary to protect the health,
45	safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach.

47	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
48	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
49 50	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed
51	as being true and correct and incorporated by reference.

57	property.
