("AAAA"), AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.				
13	WHEREAS, the City requested proposals to provide towing services on August 3, 2016,				
15	through RFP FY 2015-2016-23 and received proposals from two (2) vendors; and				
16	WHEREAS, AAAA Crosstown Towing and Recovery, Inc. (AAAA) was the only local				
17	proposer and was ranked highest by the Evaluation Committee; and				
18	WHEREAS, the proposed franchise agreement for towing services would commence an				
19	initial term on April 18, 2017 through April 17, 2020, and was initially proposed to provide up to				
20	two hundred thirty eight thousand six hundred seven (\$238,600.00) dollars over the course of				
21	five (5) years; and				
22	WHEREAS, during first reading Vice Mayor Keith London requested further negotiation				
23	and AAAA has agreed to increase the fee to a total of two hundred and sixty thousand				
24	(\$260,000.00) dollars; and				
25	WHEREAS, City Code Section 28-172 requires award of the tow services on a franchise				
26	basis and the City Charter Section 5.01(4)(d) requires a grant, renewal, or extension of a				
27	franchise agreement to be made through adoption of an ordinance.				
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF				
29	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:				
30	SECTION 1. The Mayor and the City Commission authorize the City Manager, per				
31	Section 5.01 (4) (d) of the City Charter, to award the contract for towing franchise to AAAA				
32	Crosstown Towing and recovery for an initial term commencing April 18, 2017 through April 17,				
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33 2020.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the City Commission authorizes the City Manager to 34 35 execute the agreement, and to renew the agreement for two (2) yearly renewals terms, 36 contingent upon satisfactory services and available funding. Total contract term including 37 renewals, is five (5) years.

38 **SECTION 3.** The terms, conditions, and specifications of the contract apply and shall be 39 in compliance with Section 28.172 and 28-173 of the Code of Ordinances, as amended.

40 SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of 41 resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

42 SECTION 5. In the event that any section or provision of this ordinance or any portion 43 thereof, any paragraph, sentence, or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be 44 invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or part 45 thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

46 **SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the

47 City Commission on second reading.
