FOR DESIGN OF BUS SHELTERS ON SOUTH OCEAN DRIVE (A1A) AND OTHER COROLLARY SERVICES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000.00) DOLLARS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.		
16	WHEREAS, Resolution 2014-138 authorized the City Manager to engage		
17	professional services under \$50,000 pursuant to approved continuing services		
18	agreements; and		
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20	WHEREAS, in 2013, the City partnered with FDOT to add aesthetic improvements		
21 22	to the rehabilitation of South Ocean Drive (A1A); and		
23	WHEREAS, on September 12, 2014, the City issued a purchase order to Eisman		
24	& Russo, Inc. for thirty nine thousand three hundred and sixty (\$39,360.00) dollars to		
25	produce construction documents to construct four (4) bus shelters along A1A as part of		
26	the streetscape improvement project. The City further engaged Eisman & Russo, Inc. to		
27	provide the survey and legal description for easements at a cost of six thousand seven		
28	hundred and thirty two (\$6,732) dollars; and		
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30	WHEREAS, residents subsequently requested that Staff install two (2) additional		
31	bus shelters on A1A as a part of the improvement project at South City Beach and 2030		
32	South Ocean Drive; and		
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34	WHEREAS, having designed the original four (4) shelters, Eisman & Russo, Inc.		
35	is uniquely suited to design two (2) additional correlated shelters; and		
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37 WHEREAS, the design cost of the additional shelters will be twelve thousand nine 38 hundred and twenty (\$12,920) dollars, bringing the total project expenditure with Eisman 39 & Russo over the City Manager's threshold; and 40 41 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23-8(5), the City Commission may declare a 42 finding of unique circumstances where competitive bidding may not be in the best interest 43 of the City; and 44 45 WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends finding unique circumstances to 46 authorize the City Manager to approve a work authorization to Eisman & Russo, Inc. to 47 provide the items as included in Exhibit 4 of this item, for a total amount not to exceed 48 sixty thousand (\$60,000) dollars, inclusive of the design and survey services previously 49 provided on the instant project; and 50 51 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City 52 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents. 53 54 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY 55 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA: 56 57 SECTION 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and 58 adopted herein. 59 SECTION 2. Mayor and City Commission finding of unique circumstances. 60 The Mayor and City Commission declare a finding of Unique Circumstances pursuant to 61 Chapter 23, Section 8 (5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances. 62 63 **SECTION 3.** Authorization of City Manager. The Mayor and City Commission 64 hereby authorize the City Manager to approve a work authorization to Eisman & Russo, 65 Inc. to provide the items as included in Exhibit 4 of this item, incorporated fully herein, for 66 a total amount not to exceed sixty thousand (\$60,000) dollars, inclusive of the design and 67 survey services previously provided on the instant project. 68
