TO EFFECTUATE THE PROJECT: 16 17 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 18 19 WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-20 21 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000, shall be based on 22 23 competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Section 23-5 -Award of Contract, the City Manager shall have the authority to recommend to the City 24 25 Commission award of contracts; and 26 27 WHEREAS, on February 9, 2015, the Construction Manager At-Risk (CMAR) RFP #2014-2015-010 was released, and the RFP included a two-phase award for Preconstruction Services 28 29 and for Construction Services - Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP). On January 6, 2016, 30 Resolution 2016-04 awarded the CMAR Preconstruction Services to Kaufman Lynn Construction 31 Inc. in an amount not to exceed three hundred forty eight thousand seven hundred thirty 32 (\$348,730.00) dollars; and 33 34 WHEREAS, as part of the Preconstruction Services, Kaufman Lynn is engaged in the design development of the project along with the Architect ACAI Associates, to provide assistance 35 36 in the cost containment process, materials and constructability recommendations; and 37 38 WHEREAS, a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract is a cost type open book contract where the contractor is compensated for actual costs incurred plus a fixed fee subject to 39

a ceiling price; and
