3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE WAIVER OF A RESIDENTIAL MINOR PERMIT FEE FOR THOSE REPLACING TOILETS VIA THE BROWARD WATER PARTNERSHIP CONVSERVATION PAYS TOILET REBATE PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach, and seventeen (17) other municipalities
13	adopted the Broward Water Partnership's Conservation Pays program Agreement for a five
14	(5) year term (2011-2016) in 2011; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, the program provides incentives for retrofitting existing fixtures with new
17	high efficiency plumbing fixtures through offers of free water-saving fixtures and rebates; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, residents who replace their toilets in this manner are eligible for rebates
20	of up to one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per toilet. The City of Hallandale Beach allocates
21	ninety nine (99) toilet rebates per fiscal year; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the value of the rebate is significantly hampered by the fifty (\$50.00
24	dollar fee for a residential minor permit, resulting in fewer replacements of low efficiency
25	toilets; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10-61, Fees, of the City of Hallandale Beach
28	Code of Ordinances, service or user charges or fees shall be set or amended by a Resolution
29	of the City Commission; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends waiver of the fifty (\$50.00) dolla
32	residential minor permit fee for residents, businesses and non-profits in the City of Hallandale
33	Beach that replace their toilets via the Broward Water Partnership's Conservation Pays Toile
34	Rebate Program.

36	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
37	OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

39	SECTION 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

41	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby
42	authorize the waiver of the fifty (\$50.00) dollar residential minor permit fee for residents,
43	businesses and non-profits in the City of Hallandale Beach that replace their toilet/s via the
44	Broward Water Partnership's Conservation Pays Toilet Rebate Program.

46	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately
47	upon its passage.
