6	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE
7 8	CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CREDIT BUREAU
9	SYSTEMS, INC. D/B/A AMBULANCE MEDICAL BILLING TO PROVIDE
10	AMBULANCE BILLING AND PATIENT CARE REPORT SERVICES
11 12	PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS PREVIOUSLY COMPETITIVELY SOLICITED BY THE CITY OF MIRAMAR; AND
13	PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
14 15	
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (6), Exception to Bid Requirements, the
17	City Manager is authorized to procure supplies, materials, equipment and services by way or
18	formal contracts competitively solicited by other governmental units, when the best interests o
19	the City would be served subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000
20	requires City Commission approval; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the City is currently utilizing Advanced Data Processing, Inc. (ADPI) for
23	ambulance billing and ADPI's subsidiary, Intermedix, for electronic patient care reports (ePCR)
24	under an agreement between the City of Lauderhill and ADPI. This agreement expired on March
25	31, 2017, subject to a ninety (90) day winding down period for transition; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the City of Miramar conducted a competitive solicitation in December 2015
28	and thereafter entered into a formal contract with Credit Bureau Systems d/b/a Ambulance
29	Medical Billing (AMB) at a significantly lower rate than the City's current ADPI contract; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, AMB has agreed to offer the City of Hallandale substantially the same terms
32	with the exception of including ESO patient care reporting software with no additional markup in
33	the billing fee, subject to a three (3) year initial term; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the contract terms from AMB are fiscally advantageous to the City. Monthly
36	billings with ADPI have seasonal fluctuations but average eight thousand five hundred (\$8,500)
37	dollars in costs for the City per month. Under AMB, this is estimated to be reduced to six thousand

38 39 40	five hundred and fifty (\$6,550) dollars, potentially saving the City over twenty three thousand (\$23,000.0) dollars per year; and
41	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City utilize the terms and
42	conditions competitively contracted for by the City of Miramar with AMB for rates detailed in the
43	attached memorandum; and
44	
45	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest
46	of the City and its residents to authorize the City Manager to utilize the City of Miramar contract
47	with AMB, subject to the exception for ESO and term.
48	
49	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
50	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
51	Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated
52	herein.
53	Section 2. Authorization of City Manager to expend funds. The Mayor and City
54	Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement for ambulance
55	medical billing and patient care reporting services with Credit Bureau Systems, Inc. d/b/a
56	Ambulance Medical Billing for terms offered to the City of Miramar currently under formal contract
57	and the ESO reporting services as negotiated. The Mayor and City Commission further authorize
58	the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents to facilitate said purchase.
59 60	Section 3. Effective Date: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its
61	adoption.
