10 2016-165, AND IMPLEMENTING AN INTERNAL PROCESS FOR
11 PARKING MANAGEMENT SERVICES THAT WILL BE MORE
12 COST EFFECTIVE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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15 WHEREAS, on April 22, 2016, the City of Hallandale Beach released RFP #FY2015-2016-
16 016 Parking Management Service; and
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18 WHEREAS, the City received two (2) responses to the RFP, LAZ Parking, Inc. and SP+
19 Municipal Services; and
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21 WHEREAS, on October 19, 2016, the City Commission awarded RFP #FY2015-2016-016
22 Parking Management Services to the highest ranked firm, SP+ Municipal Services, via Resolution
23 No. 2016-165, and authorized the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate an agreement;
24 and
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26 WHEREAS, contract negotiations process began soon thereafter, however, negotiations
27 were placed on hold during the transition period to the new administration; and
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29 WHEREAS, after the City Administration's reviewed the RFP, it was concluded that the
30 City could accomplish the same goals as set forth in the RFP with existing staff; and
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32 WHEREAS, the cost associated with continuing with SP+ Municipal is approximately two
33 hundred thousand (\$200,000.00) dollars annually. The City Administration will implement an
34 internal process for parking management services with existing staff will be more cost effect; and
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36 WHEREAS, the City Administration is desirous of rejecting the award of RFP #FY2015-
37 2016-016 Parking Management Services to SP+ Municipal Services, and implement an internal
38 process for parking management services with existing staff, saving the City funding for this
39 project.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. The foregoing “whereas” clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to reject the award of RFP #FY2015-2016-016 Parking Management Services to SP+ Municipal Services, and authorize implementation of an internal process for parking management services with existing staff, saving the City funding for this project.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
