27	WHEREAS, Category 2 created the Walk of Honor in which three (3) granite stone
28	structures placed along the breezeway corridor westward towards the Cultural Center and
29	would display the names of recipients of the Hallandale Beach Pioneers, the Dr. Martin
30	Luther King, Jr. Humanitarian, and the Hallandale Beach Distinguished Citizen of the Year;

32	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission hereby authorizes the rescinding of
