RESOLUTION NO. 2017-11 CRA 1 2 A RESOLUTION OF CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF 3 THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, HALLANDALE 4 BEACH. 5 FLORIDA, REJECTING THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE REISSUED RFP #2015-2016-CRA001-6 7 001; AUTHORIZING THE HBCRA EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO CONTINUE UPDATE THE CURRENT 8 TO 9 **IMPLEMENTATION** PLAN UTILIZING **IN-HOUSE** 10 RESOURCES AND CONSULTANT(S) WITHIN THE HBCRA'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S SPENDING AUTHORITY AS 11 NEEDED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 12 13 WHEREAS, the Procurement Department of the City of Hallandale Beach previously 14 15 issued RFP # 2015-2016-CRA001-001 (RFP) on behalf of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA) with respect to updating the HBCRA Implementation Plan; and 16 WHEREAS, in response to the RFP, the HBCRA received five (5) proposals and the 17 Evaluation Committee evaluated the responses from the proposers: and 18 19 WHEREAS, after final review by the HBCRA Executive Director, it was decided that due to the drastic differences in the evaluation scores by the Evaluation Committee, it was 20 recommended to reject the proposals and reissue the RFP; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the HBCRA Board of Directors previously approved the rejection of the 23 proposals and the RFP was reissued in September, 2016; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the two firms which responded to the reissued RFP are Tindale Oliver Design 26 and Strategic Development Initiatives with the cost of engaging an outside company to update 27 the HBCRA implementation plan estimated to be between \$65,000 and \$95,000; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, HBCRA staff believes that this project can be accomplished "in-house" utilizing the skills and knowledge from current employees and possibly engaging assistance from 31 an outside consultant within the spending authority of the Executive Director; and 32 33 34 WHEREAS, HBCRA staff recommends that the HBCRA Board of Directors authorize the HBCRA Executive Director to reject the proposals received pursuant to the reissued RFP and to 35 continue to update the current HBCRA Implementation Plan utilizing in-house resources and 36 consultant(s) within the Executive Director's spending authority as needed; and 37 38 WHEREAS, the HBCRA Board of Directors desires to reject the proposals received 39 pursuant to the reissued RFP and to continue to update the current HBCRA Implementation Plan 40 utilizing in-house resources and consultant(s) within the Executive Director's spending authority 41 42 as needed. 43
