29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION 30 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

31 SECTION 1. Business Tax Receipts for Medical Cannabis Business Tax. The 32 Business Tax Receipt for Medical Cannabis Retail Centers and Medical Cannabis Treatment 33 Centers is established pursuant to Exhibit "A". The Receipt fees shall be kept on file by the 34 City.

35 SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are 36 hereby repealed.

37 SECTION 3. Severability. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any 38 portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent 39 jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a 40 whole or part thereof other than the part to be declared invalid.
