12	WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 205.043, authorizes the City to levy a business tax
13	for the privilege of engaging in any business within its jurisdiction; and
14	WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, Florida approved Amendment 2 to broaden
15	legalization of medical marijuana; and
16	WHEREAS, medical marijuana treatment centers and retail centers are authorized to
17	do business in the state of Florida, and may establish businesses within the City; and
18	WHEREAS, the City intends to establish a business tax receipt for those businesses
19	related to medical marijuana including: medical marijuana retail centers, medical marijuana
20	treatment centers; and
21	WHEREAS, business tax receipts are not considered to be a license to operate a
22	business, but instead is evidence of having paid the business tax which is assessed in
23	operating the specific business in the municipality; and
24	WHEREAS, the City's fees and charges are kept on file in the City pursuant to Code
25	Section 18-37; and
26	WHEREAS, the Business Tax Receipt fees for these businesses are attached as
27	Exhibit "A" and shall be kept on file with the City; and

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29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
30	OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
31	SECTION 1. Business Tax Receipts for Medical Cannabis Business Tax. The
32	Business Tax Receipt for Medical Cannabis Retail Centers and Medical Cannabis Treatment
33	Centers is established pursuant to Exhibit "A". The Receipt fees shall be kept on file by the
34	City.
35	SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
36	hereby repealed.
37	SECTION 3. Severability. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any
38	portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent
39	jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a
40	whole or part thereof other than the part to be declared invalid.
41	<b>SECTION 4. Effective Date.</b> This ordinance shall become effective immediately after
42	final passage.
