#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE BOOKLET TO INCLUDE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH MEDICAL MARIJUANA RETAIL CENTERS, MEDICAL MARIJUANA TREATMENT FACILITIES, RELATED BUSINESS PERMITS AND CONDITIONAL USE APPROVALS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, service, user charges and fees, are set and amended by Resolution; and
WHEREAS, the City Clerk has prepared a comprehensive booklet containing fees and charges to be effective for the 2016-17 budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission amended Chapter 32, the Zoning and Land Development Code, and Chapter 7, Businesses, to address and define dispensing organizations, and related uses; and,

WHEREAS, the amendment further established application, background screening and other processes for permitting cannabis related uses; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of these regulations necessitates amendment of the fee schedule booklet to include application and Permit processing fees; and,

WHEREAS, the implementation of these regulations necessitates amendment of the fee schedule booklet to include penalties for violations of noncompliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The "Schedule of Fees and Charges" dated September 22, 2016 (Resolution \#2016-138), which is on file with the City Clerk, is hereby amended to include the fees and charges reflected in Exhibit " $A$ " as the schedule of fees and charges applicable in the City of Hallandale Beach for all charges and services rendered by the City, on or after October 1, 2016.

SECTION 2. City Manager is authorized to promulgate and publish such fees and charges and shall insure the proper collection and accounting of all monies arising therefrom. In the event of doubt or ambiguity, the City Manager is authorized to determine the appropriate fee.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to revise the appropriate fee(s) when additional fees or charges are required by Broward County or the Florida State Legislature.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
