4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS WITH BROWARD COUNTY TO PROVIDE FUNDING AND SHARED RESOURCES TOWARD THE SYSTEM-WIDE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) MUNICPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM PROGRAM (MS4); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
18	WHEREAS, this Agreement is entered into pursuant to Section 163.01, Florida
19	Statutes (2011) also known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969," and other
20	Florida law; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit
23	program was created in 1972 by the Clean Water Act (CWA) and helps to address water
24	pollution by addressing point sources (a single identifiable source of pollution) that
25	discharge pollutants to the waters of the U.S. under the CWA; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), authorizes the NPDES
28	permit program to state, tribal, and territorial governments, enabling them to perform many
29	of the permitting, administrative, and enforcement aspects of the NPDES program; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the EPA recommended that the Broward County Environmental
32	Protection and Growth Management Department (EPGMD) act as the "lead permittee"
33	and that cities within the County act as a "co-permittee"; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the City Commission authorized the City to join Broward County as a
36	co-permittee for this federally mandated NPDES stormwater permit. Twenty-five (25)
37	other Broward County cities joined Hallandale Beach as co-permittees; and
38	

39	WHEREAS, the co-permittees will continue to procure the services of the County
40	to manage and perform certain technical tasks necessary to determine the compliance
41	with the applicable portions of the permit. Therefore, the City wishes to enter into the
42	fourth (4th) cycle of the five (5) year ILA; and
43	
44	WHEREAS, Broward County has assembled and submitted a new Interlocal
45	Agreement for the City's approval; and
46	
47	WHEREAS, the County performs some of the testing and analytical requirements
48	of the permit, while the municipalities still perform the operational and record keeping
49	requirements of the permits; and
50	
51	WHEREAS, operational savings are achieved due to the fact that the County
52	performs administrative functions, including assembling all municipalities annual reports
53	and water quality testing required by the permit; and
54	
55	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission
56	authorize the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County to provide funding
57	and shared resources toward the system-wide Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
58	National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm
59	Sewer Program (MS4) under permit No. FLS000016-004; and
60	
61	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
62	Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
63	
64	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
65	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
66	
67	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
68	
69	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The City Commission hereby
70	authorizes the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) and other related
71	documents, in substantially the same form as attached to this resolution as Exhibit 2, with
72	Broward County.

74	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
75	its passage and adoption.
