Staff Summary:

Vice Mayor London requested an Agenda Item be placed on the June 21, 2017 City Commission meeting Agenda amending Section 2-31 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Compensation and Expenses of the City Commission".

The purpose of the proposed Ordinances is to amend the Code to provide the ability to revise the compensation and expenses of the City Commission by way of resolution at any time outside the budget process and to remove reference to percentages.
