Staff Summary:
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# **Background:**

On June 21, 2017, the City Commission approved Resolution #2017-70 (Exhibit 2), authorizing the City Manager or his designee to negotiate and approve, as might be needed during the summer recess, bids, contracts and/or change orders above his purchasing authority.

### **Current Situation:**

During the summer recess, the attached expenditures were processed through the Procurement Department. (Exhibit A)

#### Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Chapter 23, Procurement, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, the City Manager has authority to negotiate and award bids, contracts and/or change orders within his purchasing authority, which is \$50,000 for bids and services, and \$25,000 for professional services. The City Commission must approve all awards over the authority of the City Manager.

In accordance with Resolution #2017-70, the above expenditures are being brought to the City Commission for ratification.

# **Proposed Action:**

The City Commission ratify the expenditures listed as part of this agenda item in accordance with Resolution #2017-70.
