Short Title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR POWERED YELLOW SCHOOL ZONE INDICATOR LIGHTS TO "END SCHOOL ZONE" SIGNS IN HALLANDALE BEACH AND THROUGHOUT BROWARD COUNTY; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, THE BROWARD COUNTY COMMISSION, THE BROWARD COUNTY

LEAGUE OF CITIES, AND EACH OF THE MUNICIPALITIES IN BROWARD COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

Broward County has over 1,000 school zone locations with yellow flashing lights. The yellow flashing indicator lights are located on signs which designate the start or beginning of a school zone. The yellow flashing indicator lights are not located on "End School Zone" signs. Adding yellow flashing indicator lights to "End School Zone" signs will result in increased visibility of school zones and may result in more vehicles traveling at 15mph or less through school zones, which will result in safer school zones for students and school crossing guards.

Miami-Dade County has installed solar powered flashing indicator lights to "End School Zone" signs. Solar powered flashing indicator lights were installed on an "End School Zone" sign for research purposes on NW 31st Ave in the area of NW 38th Street in Lauderdale Lakes with great success, but the program was never pursued countywide.

Why Action is Necessary:

The installation of solar powered yellow school zone indicator lights to "End School Zone" signs in Hallandale Beach and throughout Broward County is necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida.

Proposed Action:

City Staff recommends that the City Commission of Hallandale Beach support the installation of solar powered yellow school zone indicator lights to "End School Zone" signs to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach; direct the City Clerk to transmit a copy of this resolution to the School Board of Broward County, the Broward County Commission, the Broward County League of Cities, and each of the municipalities within Broward County.
