L7	WILEDEAC in early 2040, the Florida Foot Coast (FFO) Bailway through its		
L8	WHEREAS, in early 2016, the Florida East Coast (FEC) Railway, through its		
L9	subsidiary All Aboard Florida made safety improvements on Hallandale Beach Boulevard		
20	by the railroad crossing to allow for a Quiet Zone once the FEC Brightline Passenger		
21 22	service begins; and		
23	WHEREAS, the safety improvements resulted in the elimination of the westbound		
24	to southbound left turn at this location; and

26	WHEREAS, in June of 2016, the Florida Department of Transportation		
27	("Department") removed the bollards that previously reduced eastbound Hallandale Beach		
28	Boulevard from three lanes to two as it approached the railroad tracks, and in so doing		
29	eliminated the allowance of the left turn lane and left turn movement from eastbound		
30	Hallandale Beach Boulevard to northbound NE 1 Avenue; and

32	WHEREAS, thereafter, businesses and property owners along NE 1 Avenue from		
33	Hallandale Beach Boulevard to NE 3 Street, via the City Commission, requested the let		
34	turn movement be reinstated; and		
35			
36	WHEREAS, on July 6, 2016 the City Commission voted to request the Departmen		
37	to reinstate the eastbound left turn movement on Hallandale Beach Boulevard at NE

38	Avenue using a split phase signal timing and without reinstalling the bollards, which was		
39	accomplished on July 27th, 2016; and

41	WHEREAS, thereafter the Department, Broward County, City Staff, City		
42	Administration, and the City Commission received numerous complaints about the		
43	resulting delays at the signal and regarding traffic frequently backing up into the		
44	intersection of US 1 and Hallandale Beach Boulevard; and		
45			
46	WHEREAS, on September 7, 2016, the City Commission voted to request the		
47	Department to reinstate the eastbound to northbound left turn lane with the bollards and		
48	the single phase signal, which was completed in early October 2016; and		
49			
50	WHEREAS, on December 21st, 2016 the Hallandale Beach City Commission		
51	requested for the Department to not to move forward with the permanent construction of		
52	the bollards and instead work to implement the no left turn scenario on Hallandale Beach		
53	Boulevard at the intersection of Northeast 1st Avenue.

55	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY		
56	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
