17	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") submitted application # RV-17-			
18	1933 requesting right-of-way vacation of Old Federal Highway, a 66 feet wide right-of-way			
19	for approximately 698 feet in length adjacent to the Bluesten Park redevelopment site			
20	generally located between SE 5 th Street and SE 7 th Street; and			
21				
22	WHEREAS, the vacation is necessary to accommodate the proposed			
23	redevelopment and expansion of Bluesten Park, located at 501 SE 1 st Avenue. A portion			
24	of the proposed multi-purpose field and concession/field house will be located over the			
25	right-of-way sought to be vacated; and			
26				
27	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 25-103 of the City's Code of Ordinances, following			
28	notice and a public hearing the City Commission shall grant or deny an application for			
29	vacation of right-of-way by ordinance; and			
30				
31	WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that no public interest will be			
32	adversely affected by vacation of the right-of-way, nor is the use necessary as public right-			
33	of-way, and public utility purpose easements have been agreed upon.

35	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY			
36	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:			
37				
38	SECTION 1. City Commission Findings. This ordinance has been published			
39	as required by law and that the vacation provided for in this ordinance will not adversely

40 impact any property or the general public and does not present a reasonably foreseeable41 need.

43 **SECTION 2.** Vacation of Right-of-Way. That portion of right-of-way known as 44 "Old Federal Highway" adjacent to the Bluesten Park redevelopment site generally located 45 between SE 5th Street and SE 7th Street in Hallandale Beach, Florida as shown and more 46 particularly described in attached Exhibit "1-A" is declared to be unnecessary for right-of-47 way for public purposes and is hereby vacated, abandoned, closed and discontinued for 48 use as a right-of-way.

50 <u>SECTION 3.</u> <u>City Manager Authorized</u>. The Mayor and City Commission 51 hereby authorize the City Manager to execute a "Termination and Release of Public Right-52 of-Way", in the form and substance similar to Attachment "A", to terminate that portion of 53 right-of-way legally described below and more particularly described in Exhibit "1-A":

66 <u>SECTION 4.</u> <u>Recording of Termination and Release.</u> Upon the execution of 67 one (1) original "Termination and Release of Public Right-of-Way", the City Clerk shall 68 record the "Termination and Release of Public Right-of-Way" in the Public Records of 69 Broward County, and upon recordation, the original shall be retained by the City Clerk as 70 a public record.

WHEREAS, that portion known as "Old Federal Highway" adjacent to the Bluesten Park redevelopment site lying between Southeast 7th Street and Southeast 5th Street in the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, partially described in Official Records Book 39286, page 1053 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, partially shown on Florida Department of Transportation Right of Way Map 86010-2519; was dedicated as a public right-of-way and as depicted on the plat of 601 Old Federal Highway, as recorded in Plat Book 174, page 132 of said public records, and is more particularly described in Exhibit "1-A"; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested termination and release of the Public Right-of-Way and has determined that no public interest will be adversely affected by termination and release of said public right-of-way.
