16	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") and the Florida Department of		
17	Transportation ("FDOT") are working together to enhance the City's main gateway located		
18	at I-95 and Hallandale Beach Boulevard with landscaping; and		
19			
20	WHEREAS, the FDOT requires the execution of a Maintenance Memorandum of		
21	Agreement prior to issuance of a permit to perform improvements in the right-of-way of		
22	state roads; and		
23			
24	WHEREAS, the City entered into a Landscape Inclusive Maintenance		
25	Memorandum of Agreement ("Landscape MMOA") with FDOT on March 29, 2013 via		
26	Resolution 2013-25 to outline the maintenance of landscape improvements by the City or		
27	various state roads, including Hallandale Beach Boulevard; and		
28			
29	WHEREAS, since entering into the Landscape MMOA, the City Commission has		
30	authorized Amendment One via Resolution 2014-03 and Amendment Two via Resolution		
31	2014-23 to provide for additional landscape improvements throughout the City; and		
32			
33	WHEREAS, the FDOT recently approved a request for modification from an		
34	adjacent property landowner to split the existing median on Hallandale Beach Boulevard		
35	to allow traffic to make a left hand turn to S.E. 2 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue when travelling westbound; and

37	WHEREAS, the alteration to the median will necessitate a change in landscape		
38	maintenance located on Hallandale Beach Boulevard from N.E/S.E. 1st Avenue to S.E. 2r		
39	Terrace; and

41	WHEREAS, the FDOT and the City now seek to enter into "District Four (4)		
42	Amendment Number Three (3) to the FDOT Landscape MMOA" (Exhibit 1-A) to provide		
43	for the maintenance of landscape improvements on Hallandale Beach Boulevard from		
44	N.E/S.E. 1st Avenue to S.E. 2nd Terrace. Amendment Three incorporates the existing		
45	Landscape MMOA and its subsequent amendments between the City and the FDOT into		
46	one agreement; and		
47			
48	WHEREAS, the City will maintain the landscape improvements detailed in		
49	Amendment Three at no additional cost to the City; and		
50			
51	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to execute "District Four (4)		
52	Amendment Number Three (3) to the State of Florida Department of Transportation		
53	Landscape Inclusive Memorandum of Agreement" for maintaining the improvements		
54	installed in the State's right-of-way.

56	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY		
57	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

59	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.		
60			
61	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City		
62	Manager to execute "District Four (4) Amendment Number Three (3) to the State of Florida		
63	Department of Transportation Landscape Inclusive Memorandum of Agreement," as		
64	attached in Exhibit 1-A, to provide for the maintenance of landscape improvements or		
65	Hallandale Beach Boulevard from N.E/S.E. 1st Avenue to S.E. 2nd Terrace. The City		
66	Manager is authorized to take the necessary actions to implement the project.

68	<b>SECTION 3.</b> The City Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the		
69	FDOT.

71	SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and		
72	adoption.
