20	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") has jurisdiction over N.E. 14th		
21	Avenue within the City's right-of-way, as part of the N.E. 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Corridor; and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, within the N.E. 14th Avenue Corridor, the right-of-way width of the		
24	existing road does not include sufficient multimodal infrastructure, including accessibility		
25	for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("Department") is currently		
28	developing plans known as "Financial Project ID 434690-1-52-02, Broward Mobility		
29	Hollywood-14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue from Atlantic Shores Boulevard to Sheridan Street" to construct		
30	3.1 miles of new multimodal improvements along 14th Avenue and Polk Street in the City		
31	and Hollywood; hereinafter referred to as the "Project"; and		
32			
33	WHEREAS, the Department requires that local agencies endorse the		
34	Department's delivery of a project within the local agency's right-of-way and local		
35	jurisdiction; and		
36			
37	WHEREAS, the City supports the Department's delivery of the Project, including		
38	"Section No. 1" of Project from Atlantic Shores Boulevard to Moffett Street in the City; and

40	WHEREAS, the Project is on the Broward County Metropolitan Planning			
41	Organization (MPO) list of Transportation Improvement Projects and federal funds have			
42	been allocated; and			
43				
44	WHEREAS, since the Project is an Off State Highway System Project, the			
45	Department will not provide maintenance for the facility once construction is completed;			
46	and

48	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission recognize that post completion of the			
49	Project, the City must enter into a highway maintenance agreement with the Department			
50	to establish the City's role as the local agency to provide maintenance and right-of-way			
51	certification for the Project within the City's boundaries.

53	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY			
54	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

56	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.			
57				
58	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby endorse the Florida			
59	Department of Transportation's delivery of "Financial Project Id 434690-1-52-02 Broward			
60	Mobility Hollywood-14th Avenue from Atlantic Shores Boulevard to Sheridan Street,"			
61	including multimodal improvements from Atlantic Shores Boulevard to Moffett Street in the			
62	City.

64	<b>SECTION 3.</b> The Mayor and City Commission authorize the City Manager to enter			
65	into a highway maintenance agreement with the Department after completion of the			
66	Project to establish the City's role as the local agency to provide maintenance and right-			
67	of-way certification for Project within the City's boundaries.

69	<b>SECTION 4.</b> The City Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the			
70	Department.

72	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and			
73	adoption.
