Short Title:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE III "BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES", DIVISION 4 "CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD" TO REPEAL SECTION 2-141 "CODE AND PERMITTING ADVISORY COMMITTEE"; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

During the Commission Workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13, 2017, and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed all City Advisory Boards and Committees. During said meetings the Commission provided direction on various matters concerning each City Advisory Board and Committee.

On February 13, 2017, by consensus of the Commission without opposition, the City Manager was directed to bring an item for consideration to sunset the Code and Permitting Advisory Committee. The purpose of this Advisory Committee is to identify and address issues of concern to the City relevant to its Code of Ordinances and educate residents.

The Code and Permitting Advisory Committee was created by Ordinance No. 2008-30 (Chapter 2, Article III, Division 4 or the City's Code of Ordinances). This Ordinance would need to be repealed by Ordinance to effectuate the Commissions desire to sunset the Board.

Why Action is Necessary:

This item was requested by the City Commission and pursuant to the City's Charter Article III Section 5.01 an Ordinance is required to amend or repeal any ordinance previously adopted by the City Commission.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact.

Proposed Action:

The City Commission approves this Ordinance on second reading.
