## Short Title:

### **Staff Summary:**

**Background:** 

During the Commission Workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13, 2017, and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed all City advisory boards and committees. During said meetings the Commission provided direction on various matters concerning each City advisory boards and committees. The purpose of the Joint Community Parnership Grants Committee is to review, recommend and oversees the Community Parnership Grant Program.

During said workshop meetings, by consensus of the Commission without opposition, the City Manager was directed to bring an item for consideration to sunset the Joint Community Partnership Grants Committee.

This committee was established by Resolution No. 2012-85 and Joint Resolution No. 2014J-01; therefore, approval of the proposed Resolution by the City Commission and HBCRA Board of Directors (at a future meeting) will sunset this Committee by October 1, 2017.

#### Why Action is Necessary:

This item was requested by the City Commission and pursuant to the City's Charter Article III Section 5.01 a Resolution is required for the disposition of a particular item of the administrative business of the governing body.
