4 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING  
6 CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE III "BOARDS,  
7 COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES", DIVISION 4  
8 "CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD" TO REPEAL SECTION 2-141  
9 "CODE AND PERMITTING ADVISORY COMMITTEE";  
10 PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT;  
11 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN  
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 WHEREAS, on March 7, 2006, the City Commission of Hallandale Beach adopted  
15 Ordinance No. 2006-06 to create a Code Enforcement Advisory Committee within Section  
16 2-141 of the City Code; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, on November 19, 2008, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No.  
19 2008-30 amending Section 2-141 of the City Code to rename the "Code Enforcement  
20 Advisory Committee" the "Code and Permitting Advisory Committee"; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, Section 2-35 of the City Code provides that the City Commission shall  
23 have the right to refer any matters coming before it to a committee, and that such  
24 committee shall only have the authority to investigate and make recommendations to the  
25 commission on any matters referred to it; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, the City Commission reviewed all City advisory boards and  
28 committees during City Commission Workshop meetings on February 13, 2017, March  
29 13, 2017 and April 17, 2017; and  
30

31 WHEREAS, during these workshop meetings, the City Commission directed the  
32 City Manager by consensus to repeal the Code and Permitting Advisory Committee; and  
33

34 WHEREAS, Section 5.01(g) of the City Charter requires the repeal of any  
35 ordinance previously adopted to be by ordinance; and  
36

37 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach find  
38 it is in the best interest of the City to repeal the Code and Permitting Advisory Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1. Repeal of Section 2-141.** Section 2-141 “Code and Permitting Advisory Committee” as created by Ordinance No. 2008-30 adopted on November 19, 2008 is hereby repealed. The Mayor and City Commission thanks each of the previous members for their past service and dedication to the City’s efforts.

**SECTION 2. Providing for Conflict.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. Providing for Severability.** In the event that any section or provision of this ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 4. Providing for Codification.** It is the intention of the Mayor and the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention the words “ordinance” or “section” may be changed to other appropriate words.

**SECTION 5. Providing for an Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
