Staff Summary:	

Background:

During the Commission Workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13, 2017, and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed all City advisory boards and committees. During said

meetings the Commission provided direction on various matters concerning each City advisory boards and committees.

During said workshop meetings, by consensus of the Commission without opposition, the City Manager was directed to bring an item for consideration to sunset the Marine Advisory Committee.

The purpose of the Marine Advisory Committee is to Advises the City Commission on marine matters and was established by Resolution No. 2012-85; therefore, approval of the proposed Resolution will sunset this Committee.
