b. The City Commission authorizes the utilization of fund balance to balance the Police Training, Law Enforcement Trust and Police Equitable Sharing Funds, where necessary since the dollars to be received from the State are not budgeted.

c. The City Commission authorizes the re-appropriation of \$1,278,924 from FY 2016/17 Budget to balance the General Fund from the Camera project.

SECTION 4. That when the City of Hallandale Beach receives monies from any source, be it private or governmental, by grant, gift, or otherwise, to which there is attached as a condition of acceptance, any limitation regarding the use or expenditure of the monies received, the funds so received need not be shown in the Annual Budget nor shall said budget be subject to amendment or expenditure as a result of the receipt of said monies, but said monies shall only be disbursed and applied toward the purposes for which the said funds were received. To ensure the integrity of the Operating Budget, and the integrity of the monies received by the City under grants or gifts, all monies received as contemplated above must, upon receipt, be segregated and accounted for based upon generally accepted accounting principles and placed into separate revenue and expenditure accounts established to properly account for all such funds and expenditures. Any

75	money drawn from the established expenditure accounts may only be disbursed and applied within					
76	the limitations placed upon the gift or grant.					
77	SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolu	tions				
78	in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.					
79	SECTION 6. Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of					
80	competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder					
81	hereof other than the part declared to be invalid.					
82	SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2017.
