15	WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance No. 2000-16, as may be recodified,
16	authorizing the imposition and collection of a fire protection services special assessment
17	against property throughout the City; and
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2000-16, the City utilizes
19	the uniform method for levy, collection and enforcement of the assessment, as authorized
20	by Chapter 197, Florida Statutes; and
21	WHEREAS, the projected cost for providing fire protection services to properties
22	within the City that derive a special benefit from the availability of fire protection services
23	has been evaluated; and
24	WHEREAS, Section 15 of Ordinance No. 2000-16 authorizes the annual
25	modification of the total amount of the fire protection services special assessment and the
26	amount assessed against each parcel of property.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
28	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
29	SECTION 1. The total annual cost for the provision of fire protection services to
30	be paid through the levy and collection of special assessments against properties within the
31	City is \$7,091,352 which represents eighty-five (85%) percent of the total fire protection
32	services projected budget for the 2017-2018 fiscal year.
33	SECTION 2. In accordance with Ordinance No. 2000-16, and general law,
34	properties are assessed for the 2017-2018 fiscal year in the following apportionment:
