

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING
FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE
CITY'S NORTHEAST QUADRANT THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION
GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to seek financial assistance through the
Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to improve drainage and mitigate flooding in the northeast
quadrant of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized to apply for a Hazard Mitigation Grant for
drainage improvements in the northeast quadrant of the City; and,


WHEREAS, the grant requires City match of 25%, and should the grant be awarded the
City's participation is an estimated \$500,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to apply for a grant through the
Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. The City Manager is further authorized to execute the grant
funding agreements and implement the funding, including the establishment of appropriate
accounts.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage
and adoption.
