23	authorization to Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC, (Architect/Engineer) to design, permit and

66	dollars (\$1,550,000) from the GO Bonds proceeds Contingency Account to cover additional costs			
67	for the redevelopment of Ingalls Park as part of the Parks Master Plan Phase II.

passage and adoption.
