5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ENDORSING
6 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH APPLICATION TO THE
7 BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
8 SEEKING GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE COMPLETE
9 STREETS AND OTHER LOCALIZED INITIATIVES PROGRAM
10 FOR THE N.W. 3RD STREET COMPLETE STREET EXTENSION
11 AND REVITALIZATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY
12 MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO
13 SUBMIT APPLICATIONS AND IMPLEMENT IF AWARDED;
14 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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16 **WHEREAS**, a complete street is a street where the entire right of way is planned,
17 designed, and operated for all modes of transportation and users regardless of age or ability;
18 and
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20 **WHEREAS**, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") Complete Streets
21 and Other Localized Initiatives Grant Program ("CSLIP") provides funding for small local
22 transportation projects which improve the safety and mobility for transportation users in Broward
23 County; and
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25 **WHEREAS**, the City is submitting a CSLIP application for the N.W. 3rd Street Complete
26 Street Extension and Revitalization Project ("project") in Hallandale Beach, Florida to maximize
27 existing vacant and underutilized right of way to improve heavily congested adjacent parallel
28 facilities such as Hallandale Beach Boulevard and Pembroke Road by creating an alternative
29 route; and
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31 **WHEREAS**, the project would implement formalized parallel on-street parking, maintain
32 one (1) continuous travel lane in each direction, address American with Disabilities Act
33 deficiencies, provide buffered bicycle lanes, install curb and gutter drainage, increase landscape
34 opportunities, and result in a continuous 7-foot wide sidewalk network from U.S. 1 to N.W. 8
35 Avenue; and
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37 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission endorse the Florida Department of
38 Transportation ("FDOT") delivering and fully administering the design and construction phases
39 of the projects on the City's behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission understand it is the responsibility of the City to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to FDOT policy, in scenarios where sidewalk already exists, the applicant must commit to fund that portion of the project that widens and reconfigures existing sidewalk. Therefore, the City commits to funding the sidewalk work within the existing right of way on the north and south sides of the road between Dixie Highway and N.W. 5th Terrace; and

WHEREAS, the City commits to funding operations and maintenance costs of the project, including but not limited to landscaping, all roadway maintenance, installation of street lights, and any other portion of project construction costs that exceed two (2) million dollars; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the CSLIP funding will become available in three to five years and the City will be required to provide its matching funds in the same timeframe; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission hereby endorse the N.W. 3rd Street Complete Street Extension and Revitalization Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. The foregoing “whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Endorsement and Authorization. The Mayor and the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, hereby endorse the application to the Broward MPO seeking grant funding under the CSLIP for the N.W. 3rd Street Complete Street Extension and Revitalization Project. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to submit applications and implement if awarded.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
