8 SEEKING GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE COMPLETE
9 STREETS AND OTHER LOCALIZED INITIATIVES PROGRAM
10 FOR THE UPGRADE OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL TECHNOLOGY
11 ALONG HALLANDALE BEACH BOULEVARD AND SOUTH
12 FEDERAL HIGHWAY (US-1) WITH AN ADAPTIVE TRAFFIC
13 CONTROL SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
14 EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT
15 APPLICATIONS AND IMPLEMENT IF AWARDED; AND
16 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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18 **WHEREAS**, a complete street is a street where the entire right of way is planned,
19 designed, and operated for all modes of transportation and users regardless of age or ability;
20 and
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22 **WHEREAS**, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") Complete Streets
23 and Other Localized Initiatives Grant Program ("CSLIP") provides funding for small local
24 transportation projects which improve the safety and mobility for transportation users in Broward
25 County; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the City is submitting a CSLIP application to upgrade the traffic signal
28 technology along Hallandale Beach Boulevard and South Federal Highway ("US-1") to use an
29 Adaptive Traffic Control System ("ATCS"); and
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31 **WHEREAS**, ATCS is a traffic management strategy in which traffic signal timing
32 changes or adapts based on actual traffic demand, optimizing signal timing for arterials, side
33 streets and pedestrians through real-time automated adaptive traffic control; and
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35 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission endorse the Florida Department of
36 Transportation ("FDOT") delivering and fully administering the design and construction phases
37 of the projects on the City's behalf; and
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39 **WHEREAS**, the FDOT District 6 has sent the City a letter of support for the project,
40 which will be implemented within the FDOT right of way; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission understand it is the responsibility of the City to fund operations and maintenance of the project and any construction cost in excess of two (2) million dollars; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the CSLIP funding will become available in three to five years and the City will be required to provide its matching funds in the same timeframe; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission hereby endorse the upgrade traffic signal technology along Hallandale Beach Boulevard and US-1 to use ATCS.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. The foregoing “whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Endorsement and Authorization. The Mayor and the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, hereby endorse applications to the Broward MPO seeking grant funding under the CSLIP for the upgrade of current traffic signal technology along Hallandale Beach Boulevard and US-1 to use an Adaptive Traffic Control System. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to submit applications and implement if awarded.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
