17	WHEREAS, on October 11, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County,
18	Florida adopted Ordinance No. 2011-19 (the "Code of Ethics"), which implemented a Code of Ethics
19	for elected municipal officials; and
20	WHEREAS, the Code of Ethics establishes certain conditions and disclosure obligations on
21	elected officials who engage in fundraising on behalf of charitable organizations; and
22	WHEREAS, Section 1-19(C)(5)(A)(4) of the Code of Ethics provides that the additional
23	obligations shall not apply to an elected official who raises funds for those charities and events
24	which are formally approved by elected official's municipality; and
25	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach desire to
26	designate the charities and organizations listed in Exhibit "A," a copy of which is attached hereto and
27	incorporated herein, as formally approved by the City of Hallandale Beach, and therefore exempted
28	from the charitable fundraising disclosure reporting provisions.
29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
30	HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
31	SECTION 1. Resolution 2013-31 is hereby rescinded.
32	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission designate the charities and organizations

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33	listed in Exhibit "A," hereto attached, as formally exempted from the fundraising disclosure
34	provisions of The Broward County Ethics Code Section 1-19(C)(5)(A)(4).
35	SECTION 3. Restrictions. Inclusion as an approved Charity or Event shall not impose any
36	duty or liability upon the City, and shall not serve as the basis for any claim by any person against
37	the City.
38	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage
39	and adoption.
