13	WHEREAS, cities participating in the CDBG program receive an allocation of funds		
14	based on a funding formula developed by the Department of Housing and Urban		
15	Development ("HUD"); and		
16			
17	WHEREAS, the City applies for funds through the Community Development Block		
18	Grant Program (CDBG) annually. The allocation is automatic and non-competitive,		
19	provided the allocation is for HUD/CDBG eligible activities (which may include capital,		
20	economic development, and housing and public service projects). Although the allocation		
21	is automatic, cities must apply to receive funding; and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two projects during this CDBG funding cycle:		
24	the continuation of the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center, and Public		
25	Works improvements in the Southwest Quadrant; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, pursuant to the CDBG Program's requirements, on November 12,		
28	2015, the City conducted an advertised public meeting to receive public comment		
29	regarding proposed City projects, as well as projects the community would like to see		
30	implemented; and		
31			
32	WHEREAS, in the 41st Year CDBG funding cycle, the Hepburn Center After School		
33	Tutorial Program was awarded ninety four thousand three hundred fifty five dollars		
34	(\$94,355.00) and the Public Works Improvements Project was awarded one hundred eight		
35	thousand two hundred (\$108,200.00) dollars for a total of two hundred eight thousand two		
36	hundred (\$202,555.00) dollars; and

38	WHEREAS, although the allocation has not yet been released by LULD, it

WHEREAS, although the allocation has not yet been released by HUD, the Broward County Housing and Community Development Division advised the City to utilize

40	the application amounts from the previous year when completing the 42 nd Year (CDBG);

43	WHEREAS, should the allocation of funds be less or more than the requested		
44	amount, the scope of work for both projects will be adjusted accordingly; and

46	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends authorization for the submittal of		
47	the two (2) grant applications for the 42nd Year (FY 2016-2017) CDBG Project; and		
48			
49	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to apply for funding under the 42nd		
50	Year Community Development Block Grant Program.		
51 52 53 54	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:		
55	SECTION 1. City Commission Authorization. The Mayor and City		
56	Commission hereby authorize the submission of the two (2) grant applications: the City of		
57	Hallandale Beach's Public Works Improvements in the SW Quadrant (drainage, sewer		
58	lines, water lines, sidewalks, regarding/sodding of swales and other related infrastructure		
59	improvements), and the Friends of the Hepburn Center's After School Tutorial Project		
60 61	under the 42 nd Year Community Development Block Grant Program on behalf of the City.		
62	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to		
63	execute and implement all necessary funding agreement documents.
