15 16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") Policy Manual regulates the procedures used to accomplish the goals of the HBCRA's Implementation Plan, and the HBCRA's most recent Policy Manual was approved by the Board of Directors of the HBCRA in November, 2013 and revised in April 2016 in order to amend terms for the Business Façade Program; and
20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, the HBCRA Policy Manual created in 2013 established new guidelines for the Residential Programs: First Time Homebuyer's Program (FTHB), Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP), Replacement Home Program (RHP), Hurricane Shutter/Impact Glass Program (HSIGP) and the Paint Program (PP); and
24 25 26	WHEREAS, HBCRA staff has recommended moving away from a single Policy Manual to individual Residential Program policies in order for applicants to better understand the application and process; and for staff to better manage the residential programs; and
27 28 29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the HBCRA staff has recommended certain modifications to the Residential Programs as set forth in the revised HBCRA Residential Policy dated February 2018 as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" which modifications will allow the HBCRA to achieve higher impact community redevelopment and revitalization which is a goal outlined in the current HBCRA Implementation Plan; and
