2 ORDINANCE NO. 2018 -

3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
4 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING  
5 CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION", SECTION 2-39 "POLICE  
6 AND FIREFIGHTERS' BOARD OF TRUSTEES", TO ALLOW  
7 FOR COMMISSION APPOINTMENT OF CITY RESIDENTS TO  
8 PENSION BOARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING  
9 FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND  
10 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Commission have determined that it is in the best  
12 interest of the residents of the City to allow for the appointment of residents of the city, as  
13 permitted by state law, to the Police and Firefighters Board of Trustees.

14 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
15 HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

17 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.

18 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 2 "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of  
19 Hallandale Beach, Florida is hereby amended to read as follows:

20  
21 **Sec. 2-39. - Police and firefighters' board of trustees.**

22 The city commission shall appoint two individuals, either city commissioners or other legal  
23 resident of the city, to serve as regular members of the City of Hallandale Beach Police  
24 Officers' and Firefighters' Board of Trustees. The city commission's appointment of its  
25 members to serve as members of the Hallandale Police Officers' and Firefighters' Board of  
26 Trustees, shall serve as an ex officio duty of their office as city commissioner. ~~The~~ Any city  
27 commissioners appointed to the City of Hallandale Beach Police Officers' and Firefighters'  
28 Board of Trustees shall perform their ex officio duties as members of the City of Hallandale  
29 Beach Police Officers' and Firefighters' Board of Trustees as authorized by law.

30  
31 **SECTION 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City  
32 of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the  
33 extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 5. Codification.** It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate words.

**SECTION 6. Effective date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
