

## **DESCRIPTION**

Broward County Mayor Beam Furr and Commissioner Nan Rich, Chair of the Broward County Climate Change Task Force, will co-host this event, inviting the participation of municipal officials and business leadership in our community.

We ask that each municipality be represented by its mayor or another member of its commission, and by its city manager or a senior administrator with resilience responsibilities (e.g., director of sustainability, environmental management, public works, etc.).

Conversation will focus on the latest climate and resilience developments in Broward County with a facilitated discussion regarding community concerns, collective advancements, and the need for regional resilient planning and investment.

We expect to hold this Roundtable annually as part of a broader effort to address our community's resilience needs and advance a regional resilience strategy.

There is NO cost to attend, and lunch will be provided.
