3 4 5 6 7	AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, CODIFYING SECTION 2-106 "EDUCATION ADVISORY BOARD" IN CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE III "BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES"; TO APPLY GENERAL ADVISORY
8 9 10	BOARD PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12	WHEREAS, during the commission workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13,
13	2017 and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed the composition, powers and
14	responsibilities of all City Advisory Boards and Committees; and
15	WHEREAS, on April 3, 2013, the City Commission approved the establishment of an
16	eight (8) member Education Advisory Board with the mission to research program and resource
17	opportunities for the City to partner with the schools, recommend actions to support the
18	educational facilities, and increase interaction and coordination between local schools
19	businesses; and
20	WHEREAS, in 2016 the Broward County School Board approved the merger of
21	Hallandale Elementary and Gulfstream Middle to Gulfstream Academy of Hallandale Beach K-8
22	Elementary for the school year 2016-17 to be housed at the former Hallandale Adult Education
23	Center and the composition of the advisory board was amended in February 2018 to reflect the
24	change; and
25	WHEREAS, in May 2018, the city Commission approved codification of general provisions
26	applying to all advisory boards and to codify all advisory boards; and
27	WHERAS, the City administration recommends that it is in the best interest of the
28	residents of the City to codify the existing Education Advisory Board subject to the general rules
29	applicable to all advisory boards and committees.
30	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
31	HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

33	SECTION	1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.
34	SECTION	2. Chapter 2 "Administration," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
35	Hallandale Beach	n, Florida, Division 2, "Advisory Boards and Committees" is amended to read
36	as follows:

38	ARTICLE	III BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES
39	DIVISION	2. ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES
40	Sec. 2-100	6. – Education Advisory Board
41	(a) There	is hereby created an Education Advisory Board as an advisory board to the
42	city co	mmission of the City of Hallandale Beach.
43	(b) <u>Memb</u>	ers. The board shall consist of eight (8) voting members appointed as follows:
44	a.	Member of the Parent Teacher Organization - Gulfstream Academy of
45		Hallandale Beach K-8 Elementary (parent or guardian of a child enrolled
46		within the school)
47	b.	Member of the Parent Teacher Organization - Gulfstream Academy of
48		Hallandale Beach K-8 Elementary (parent or guardian of a child enrolled
49		within the school)
50	C.	Member of the Parent Teacher Organization - Hallandale High School
51		(parent or guardian of a child enrolled within the school)
52	d.	Mayor Appointment: one resident who has a background- in education and
53		interest in the field of education
54	e.	Commissioner Appointment (Seat 1): one resident who has a background in
55		education and interest in the field of education
56	f.	Commissioner Appointment (Seat 2): one resident who has a background in
57		education and interest in the field of education
58	g.	Commissioner Appointment (Seat 3): one resident who has a background in
59		education and interest in the field of education
60	h.	Commissioner Appointment (Seat 4): one resident who has a background in
61		education and interest in the field of education
62		
63		(c) The city manager shall provide adequate professional staff for the
64	<u>operat</u>	ional support of the board.

65	(d) Powers and duties. In addition to those responsibilities required of all
66	advisory boards and committees, the Education Advisory Board shall research
67	program and resource opportunities for the City to partner with the schools,
68	recommend actions to support the educational facilities, and increase interaction and
69	coordination between local schools businesses.
70	
71	
72	SECTION 3. Terms and appointments existing as of the effective date of this ordinance
73	will continue as scheduled subject to City Commission approval.
74	
75	SECTION 4. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City
76	of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the
77	extent of such conflict.
78	
79	SECTION 5. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a
80	court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the
81	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.
82	
83	SECTION 6. Codification. It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that the
84	provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such
85	intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate words.
86	
87	SECTION 7. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
88	adoption.
