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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
4 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,  
5 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCURE  
6 TEMPORARY BUILDING PLAN REVIEW AND INSPECTION  
7 SERVICES FROM CALVIN, GIORDANO & ASSOCIATES, INC.  
8 AND C.A.P. GOVERNMENT, INC. PURSUANT TO RFP #575-  
9 11849 OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE IN AN AMOUNT  
10 NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR  
11 THOUSAND (\$354,000) DOLLARS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-  
12 18; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL  
13 RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE  
14 PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES AS NEEDED; AND  
15 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) Bids and Contracts from other entities, the  
18 City Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services  
19 pursuant to competitive bids and formal contracts of other governmental units when the best  
20 interests of the City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess  
21 of \$50,000.00 requires City Commission approval; and

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23 WHEREAS, on May 16, 2017, the City of Fort Lauderdale awarded RFP #575-11849,  
24 to Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. and C.A.P. Government, Inc. for inspection and plan  
25 review services for a 2-year term with 2 optional 1-year renewals; and

27 WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach Building Division Summer Study conducted  
28 in July 2017 revealed a substantial backlog in permit processing, thus demonstrating the need  
29 to increase the availability of supplemental plan examiners and inspectors on a temporary  
30 basis in an effort to improve the level of service; and

32 WHEREAS, the City Administration concludes that it is in the best interest of the City  
33 of Hallandale Beach to utilize the City of Fort Lauderdale's contracts with Calvin, Giordano &  
34 Associates, Inc. and C.A.P. Government, Inc. pursuant to RFP #575-11849, as may be further  
35 amended, to procure inspection and plan review services in an amount not to exceed three  
36 hundred fifty-four thousand (\$354,000) dollars for fiscal year 2017-18.

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION  
39 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

40 SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

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42 SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby  
43 authorize the City Manager to execute 2-year contracts with 2 optional 1-year renewals for  
44 temporary building plan review and inspection services as needed from Calvin Giordano &  
45 Associates, Inc. and C.A.P. Government, Inc. pursuant to RFP #575-11849 of the City of Fort  
46 Lauderdale, as may be further amended, in an amount not to exceed three hundred fifty-four  
47 thousand (\$354,000) dollars for fiscal year 17-18, and the budgeted amounts in future fiscal  
48 years. The City Manager is authorized to take all necessary actions to implement the project  
49 as provided for in the fiscal year 2017-18 budget.

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51 SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its  
52 adoption.
