17	WHEREAS, the Hurricane HSIGP program provides residents with a rebate of up to		
18	\$1,500 to assist with the installation of shutters or impact glass for the prevention of storm related		
19	damages. This rebate payment is made to eligible residents after shutters or impact glass work		
20	has been completed and permits finalized; and

22	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the approved FY17/18 budget for the City's HSIGP program was \$75,000.		
23	There is currently \$1,500 remaining of the budget amount of \$75,000. The proposed FY18/19		
24 25	budget for the City's HSIGP is \$90,000; and		
25 26	WHEREAS, City Administration recommends the City Commission adopt the proposed		
20	policy which sets forth guidelines to govern this program. If adopted, the City's policy would		
28	establish the guidelines for administering this program; and		
29	establish the guidelines for duministering this program, and

31	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commissioner have determined that the recommendation		
32	of the administration is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach, and its residents.
