WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) Bids and Contracts from other entities, the City Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services pursuant to competitive bids and formal contracts of other governmental units when the best interests of the City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000.00 requires City Commission approval; and

EFFECTUATE THE PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES AS

NEEDED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach currently uses two Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition ("SCADA") platforms: GE IFix and Data Flow Systems ("DFS"). The GE IFix platform is utilized for the Water Treatment Plant, and the DFS platform is used for the twenty-eight (28) ancillary remote facilities such as sewer lift stations, stormwater stations and water towers; and

WHEREAS, the City's platforms allow for monitoring and control from the City water plant main control room, where operators monitor the water plant and remote site operations; and

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined it is necessary to upgrade to a single state-of-the-art, non-proprietary operating platform, which will allow the City to

37	expand the SCADA system in the future, operate with sharper graphics, and allow City
38	staff to monitor alarms and control remote sites from their desks; and
39	WHEREAS, on July 10, 2012, the City Commission of Sunrise, Florida awarded
40	RFP No. (12)H-02 to Revere Control Systems, Inc. for SCADA services, materials and
41	equipment. The City of Sunrise renewed the contract through September 30, 2018; and

43	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best
44	interest of the City and its residents to authorize a contract for SCADA services, materials
45	and equipment to Revere Control Systems, Inc. at a cost not to exceed one hundred thirty
46	nine thousand five hundred and ninety five dollars (\$139,595), inclusive of a 10%
47	contingency pursuant to the terms of RFP No. (12)h-02 awarded by the City of Sunrise
48	Florida.

50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY

59	pursuant to the terms of RFP No. (12)h-02 awarded by the City of Sunrise, Florida. The
60	City Manager is authorized to execute all related documents to effectuate the procurement
61	of services, materials, and equipment as needed.
