## 1 **EXHIBIT 1** 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2018** 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF 4 5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN 6 7 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR SHARING THE COST OF THE 100-YEAR FLOOD ELEVATION 8 9 MAP AND ASSOCIATED MODELING FOR AN EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED SIXTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED 10 TWENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-SEVEN CENTS 11 12 (\$16,428.57); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND 13 CONDITIONS OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AND 14 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 15 WHEREAS, in 2016, Broward County ("County") adopted the updated Unified Sea Level 16 17 Rise Projection for the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Compact and directed staff to apply this projection as the basis for regional sea level rise adaptation planning; and 18 19 WHEREAS, in 2017, the County directed its Environmental Protection and Growth 20 Management Department to create and maintain a future conditions map series to include 21 22 average wet season groundwater elevations and 100-year flood elevations to account for 23 predicted changes in water levels and ensure the resiliency of current and future infrastructure 24 investments; and 25 WHEREAS, in 2018, the County entered into an agreement (the "100-Year Flood 26 27 Agreement") with Geosyntec Consultants Inc. ("Consultant"), an engineering consulting company, 28 to develop a County-wide 100-Year Flood Elevation Map and associated modeling, at a total cost 29 not to exceed seven hundred seventeen thousand eight hundred ninety-four dollars (\$717,894) 30 in response to Request for Proposals # R2114367P1; and 31 WHEREAS, the County has identified ten (10) local government partners willing to 32 collectively share the cost fifty percent (50%) of the 100-Year Flood Agreement costs. Each local 33 34 government participating must execute an Interlocal Agreement with the County; and 35 WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Hallandale Beach and County 36

provides for the sharing of cost in the amount not to exceed sixteen thousand four hundred twenty-
