5 6	THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO BID NUMBER		
7	150451 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEESBURG, FLORIDA AND		
8 9	ODYSSEY MANUFACTURING COMPANY FLORIDA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY THOUSAND (\$80,000)		
10	DOLLARS WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE USE AND		
11 12	MAINTENANCE OF THREE (3) 3,000 GALLON BULK STORAGE TANKS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE		
13	ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE		
14 15	PURCHASE AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2018- 2019 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.		
16	2019 BODGET, AND I ROVIDING FOR AN ELL ECTIVE DATE.		
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) "Exception to Bid Requirements" of the City of		
18	Hallandale Beach ("City") Code, the City Manager is authorized to use competitive bids and formal		
19	contracts from other entities when the best interests of the City would be served, subject to the		
20	requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and		
21			
22	WHEREAS, sodium hypochlorite is used as a disinfectant to help maintain bacteria-free		
23	water in the City's on-site water storage and in the City-wide distribution system; and		
24			
25	WHEREAS, the City Commission of Leesburg, Florida awarded Invitation to Bid No.		
26	150451 to Odyssey Manufacturing Company ("Odyssey") for the purchase of sodium		
27	hypochlorite, valid until September 30, 2018, which was recently renewed for an additional three		
28	year term through September 30, 2021 at a fixed price of \$0.56 with no fuel surcharges, delivery		
29	fees or other charges; and

31	WHEREAS, on October 4, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2017-118		
32	authorizing the purchase of sodium hypochlorite for FY 2017-2018 from Odyssey pursuant to ITB		
33	Number 150451 between the City of Leesburg, Florida and Odyssey. Odyssey agreed to furnish,		
34	install and maintain three (3) 3,000 gallon sodium hypochlorite bulk storage tanks ("tanks") inside		
35	the existing concrete containment at the City's Water Treatment Plant at no charge; and		
36			
37	WHEREAS, at the end of two years of sodium hypochlorite service, the City will own the		

tanks and the associated piping at no charge. In the interim, Odyssey will perform any required

maintenance on or replacements to the tanks; and

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40	WHEREAS, the City Administration con	cludes that it is in the best interest of the City of	
41	Hallandale Beach to utilize the City of Leesburg's contract with Odyssey to purchase sodium		
42	hypochlorite priced at \$0.56 per gallon in an amount not to exceed eighty thousand dollars		
43	(\$80,000) for Fiscal Year 2018-2019, and to authorize the continued use and maintenance of the		
44	tanks.		
45	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF		
46	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

48	SECTION 1. City Manager Authoriza	ation. The Mayor and City Commission hereby	
49	authorize the City Manager to purchase sodium hypochlorite from Odyssey pursuant to ITB		
50	Number 150451 between the City of Leesburg, Florida and Odyssey in an amount not to exceed		
51	eighty thousand (\$80,000) dollars, and to authorize the continued use and maintenance of three		
52	(3) 3,000 gallon bulk storage tanks. The City Manager is authorized to take all necessary actions		
53	to implement the project as provided for in the fiscal year 2018-2019 budget.

55	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Re	esolution shall take effect immediately upon its	
56	passage and adoption.
