RESOLUTION NO. 2018-094

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO BID NUMBER 150451 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEESBURG, FLORIDA AND ODYSSEY MANUFACTURING COMPANY FLORIDA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY THOUSAND (\$80,000) DOLLARS WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THREE (3) 3,000 GALLON BULK STORAGE TANKS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) "Exception to Bid Requirements" of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") Code, the City Manager is authorized to use competitive bids and formal contracts from other entities when the best interests of the City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, sodium hypochlorite is used as a disinfectant to help maintain bacteria-free water in the City's on-site water storage and in the City-wide distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Leesburg, Florida awarded Invitation to Bid No. 150451 to Odyssey Manufacturing Company ("Odyssey") for the purchase of sodium hypochlorite, valid until September 30, 2018, which was recently renewed for an additional three year term through September 30, 2021 at a fixed price of \$0.56 with no fuel surcharges, delivery fees or other charges; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2017-118 authorizing the purchase of sodium hypochlorite for FY 2017-2018 from Odyssey pursuant to ITB Number 150451 between the City of Leesburg, Florida and Odyssey. Odyssey agreed to furnish, install and maintain three (3) 3,000 gallon sodium hypochlorite bulk storage tanks ("tanks") inside the existing concrete containment at the City's Water Treatment Plant at no charge; and

WHEREAS, at the end of two years of sodium hypochlorite service, the City will own the tanks and the associated piping at no charge. In the interim, Odyssey will perform any required maintenance on or replacements to the tanks; and
