18	WHEREAS, on June 5, 2018, the Broward County Commission ("County Commission")		
19	voted to place the approval of a 1% Transportation Surtax Levy for consideration by County voters		
20	as a referendum item on the November 6 th , 2018 ballot; and

22	WHEREAS, on June 5, 2018, the County Commission also enacted Ordinance No. 2018-		
23	29, the Broward County Transportation Surtax Ordinance, which provided a process by which any		
24	municipality within Broward County may apply for project funding from surtax proceeds. The		

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2018, the County Commission also enacted Ordinance No. 2018-29, the Broward County Transportation Surtax Ordinance, which provided a process by which any municipality within Broward County may apply for project funding from surtax proceeds. The process includes a request that the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") review and rank all municipal projects based on each project's ability to alleviate traffic congestion and enhance connectivity. The ordinance also established an independent oversight board to ensure transparency and objectivity in the review of applications for funding from surtax proceeds; and

WHEREAS, the County has provided municipalities in Broward County with a proposed Interlocal Agreement for Broward County, the MPO and municipalities within Broward County to sign, attached as Exhibit 2 ("Interlocal Agreement") and

WHEREAS, Section VI of the Interlocal Agreement states that the Interlocal Agreement shall become effective only if, on or before September 30, 2018, the MPO and municipalities representing the majority of the population of Broward County formally approve, execute, and return the executed Agreement to the County; and

 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission conclude that executing the Interlocal Agreement is in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

- **SECTION 1.** Recitals Adopted. That each of the above recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.
- **SECTION 2. Findings Adopted.** The City formally makes the following findings as required by Interlocal Agreement Recital "C":
 - 1. Without a dedication of substantial new revenues, the existing transit system within Broward County will not be sustainable, alternative modes of transportation will not be realized, and traffic congestion will continue to worsen;
 - 2. The ten-year Transportation Development Plan approved by the County Commission on January 9, 2018, identifies that the County's transit system will be substantially underfunded by 2025, despite the current dedication of substantial ad valorem tax revenues to subsidize transit operations;
 - 3. The proposed transportation surtax would enable the advancement of transportation and premium transit projects presently identified in the MPO's Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan and the current five-year Transportation improvement Program, and would provide funding for roadway capital investment projects that would improve safety, reduce congestion, and advance multimodal mobility options for residents and visitors, which projects are currently infeasible for reasons including a lack of dedicated revenue for operations and maintenance; and
 - 4. Critically, the proposed transportation surtax would provide a dedicated funding source that would enable the County to leverage revenues contributed by residents and visitors to obtain federal transportation grants available only to grant applicants that can demonstrate the financial resources to build, operate, and maintain, through their useful lives, major transportation projects, thereby bringing back to Broward County more of the tax dollars paid by local residents and businesses that would otherwise be allocated to other counties and states. The proposed surtax would enable the County to compete directly for, and work collaboratively with other governmental and private partners to acquire, certain discretionary state and federal funding to advance the mobility goals of the region.

72	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization	on. The Mayor and City Commission hereby	
73	authorize the City Manager to execute the Inte	rlocal Agreement between Broward County,	
74	participating municipalities, and the Broward County MPO, in substantially the form attached as		
75	"Exhibit 2", if approved by voters in the November 6th, 2018 election. The City Manager is further		
76	directed to return the original, executed Interlocal Agreement to the County, together with a copy		
77	of this Resolution, and to scan and email an executive copy of the Agreement to the County		
78	Administrator and County Attorney, in the manner provided in the Interlocal Agreement, on or		
79	before September 30, 2018. The City Manager is authorized to take all necessary actions to		
80	implement the terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement.		
81	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Reso	ution shall take effect immediately upon its	
82	passage and adoption.
