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WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City uses standardized sewer pumps, which they purchase from the following four (4) manufacturers: 1). Myers, 2). KSB, 3). EBARA International Corporation, and 4). Gould's Water Technology; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for BID # FY 2017-2018-015 consists of the purchase of standardized pumps for the fifteen (15) sewer lift stations that the City maintains and operates. The City may only purchase specified pumps from the authorized dealers from the brands stated in the Bid. The City may purchase additional pumps on an

48 at 11:00 AM and two (2) vendors were in attendance; and

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50 **WHEREAS**, two (2) bids were received from Custom Pump & Controls, Inc. and
51 F.J. Nugent & Associates, Inc.; and

53 **WHEREAS**, Custom Pump & Controls, Inc. was the only responsible and
54 responsive bid providing pricing for Meyers and KSB manufacturer pumps, and F.J.
55 Nugent & Associates, Inc. was the only responsible and responsive bid providing pricing
56 for Ebara International Corporation manufacturer pumps. No bid provided pricing for
57 Gould's Water Technology Manufacturer pumps; and

59 **WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award
60 BID # FY 2017-2018-0015, City of Hallandale Beach Purchase of Sewer Lift Stations
61 Pumps to the lowest responsive responsible bidders, Custom Pump & Controls, Inc. in an
62 amount not to exceed one hundred four thousand four hundred and one dollars (\$104,401)
63 inclusive of a thirteen percent contingency, and to F.J. Nugent & Associates, Inc. in an
64 amount not to exceed sixteen thousand twenty two dollars (\$16,022) inclusive of a thirteen
65 percent contingency, on an as needed basis, for a period of two (2) years, renewable to a
66 maximum of three (3) additional one (1) year terms; and

68 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
69 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

74 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.

SECTION 2. City Commission Action. The Mayor and City Commission hereby award BID # FY 2017-2018-0015, City of Hallandale Beach Purchase of Sewer Lift Stations Pumps to the lowest responsive responsible bidders, Custom Pump & Controls, Inc. and F. J. Nugent & Associates, Inc.

SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with Custom Pump & Controls, Inc. in an amount not to exceed one hundred and four thousand four hundred and one dollars (\$104,401) inclusive of a thirteen percent contingency, and to F.J. Nugent & Associates, Inc. in an amount not to exceed sixteen thousand twenty two dollars (\$16,022) inclusive of a thirteen percent contingency, on an as needed basis, both for a period of two (2) years, renewable for a maximum of three (3) additional one (1) year terms. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute all related documents to effectuate this project.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
